ARRIVE EARLY AND ALLOW EXTRA TIME TO ENTER THE STADIUM
Expect Black Friday traffic at American Dream Mall in addition to event traffic.

DePaul Catholic, Passaic County Tech, Northern Valley Old Tappan, Don Bosco

VISITING TEAMS: Guests Sit in Sections 133-144 (West Side)
Paramus Catholic, Washington Township, Cedar Creek, St. Joseph Regional

Parking - Lots E, F, and G - Open at 8:00 AM

Parking Fee: \$20 per vehicle
Payment Options: Parking is payable upon entry available.
Credit cards and cash accepted at entry plazas; have payment ready at entrance

NJ Transit Rail Service & Coach USA Bus Service are NOT in service.

NJ Transit Bus Lines

- NJ Transit bus lines 160 and 703 service the Sports Complex and American Dream daily
- Check NJTransit.com for schedule details

Rideshare (Uber, Lyft, etc.)

- Rideshare drop-off is located on the roadway between Lots D and E
- Rideshare pickup is in Lot E
- Surge pricing is often in effect after the event; larger crowds will result in longer pickup wait times (up to 2 hours)



TAILGATING & ALCOHOL POLICY

- Tailgating is permitted to enjoy food and **non-alcoholic** beverages before and after playoff games
- All guests must adhere to the Stadium's [tailgating policies](#)
- **NO alcoholic beverages are allowed on the premises (including parking lots) as they are strictly prohibited by the NJSIAA**



FAMILY BAG POLICY IS EFFECT!

- All types of bags 12" x 12" x 12" or smaller in size are permitted
- Does not have to be clear
- Limit one bag per person



SECURITY SCREENING

- All guests will be subject to a courteous screening via a walk-through metal detector at the stadium gates
- Place cell phones, keys, metal objects on the security table before walking through the metal detector
- Belts and jewelry do not need to be removed
- Guests should only bring items they absolutely need inside the stadium



TICKETING

- Box Office trailer is located outside the MetLife Gate
 - Opens at 8am and closes at halftime of final game
 - All ticketholders should enter the MetLife Gate
- Tickets are General Admission
 - Home Team Guests sit on the East Side in Sections 108-118
 - Visiting Team Guests sit on the West Side in Sections 133-144
 - See top of previous page for a list of home and visiting teams
- Purchase tickets in advance on Ticketmaster.com to avoid long lines on game day
- All guests over 34" tall must have their own ticket



MOBILE TICKETING

- Barcodes for ticket scanning will appear on mobile tickets 8 hours prior to the event
- Your ticket must be displayed on your phone to enter the event
- Download your mobile ticket before you enter the security line



RE-ENTRY IS NOT PERMITTED

- If you leave the stadium you will not be allowed to re-enter with the same event ticket
- You will need to purchase a new ticket to re-enter



PERMITTED ITEMS

- Non-professional still photography camera with a lens that is 4" or less in length (no case or detachable lens)
- Empty reusable water bottles (plastic or aluminum), no larger than 20 oz.
- Factory sealed canned or plastic water/soft-drink bottles 20 oz. or less
- Food in a clear plastic bag or wrapping
- Ponchos or raincoats (no umbrellas!)
- Binoculars (not in a case)
- Small portable phone charger
- Handheld sign that is no larger than 11"x17" and does not obstruct the view of other guests; cannot be attached to sticks or poles
- Small, collapsible (unbrella-style) strollers that can fit under your seat; there is no storage available
- Battery-operated clothing, as long as the battery is no larger than a cell phone and can be disconnected for security screening
- Medically necessary items



PROHIBITED ITEMS

- NO cameras with a lens longer than 4"
- NO drones, video cameras, audio recording devices, GoPro's, iPads, tablets or selfie sticks
- NO signs, banners, or flags larger than 11"x17"
- NO umbrellas (bring a raincoat/poncho instead!)
- NO laser pointers, flares, smoke devices, fireworks, noisemakers, strollers
- NO alcohol of any kind anywhere on premises
- NO seat cushions except those for medical needs
- NO glass bottles, coolers, thermoses or ice chests
- NO weapons of any kind
- NO displaying of indecent messages/language on any printed material, including but not limited to, clothing, hats, signs, banners, flags, etc. per the MetLife Stadium [Guest Code of Conduct](#).
- Any other item deemed inappropriate by stadium management

ALL ITEMS ARE SUBJECT TO INSPECTION UPON ENTRY

Unauthorized soliciting, sampling, peddling of any product/food/drink is not permitted
